- WHO:** The Presbyterian Youth Triennium is a gathering of 6,000 Presbyterian youth and adults from the Cumberland Presbyterian Church and the Presbyterian Church (USA). Participants must be at least 15 years old and no older than 19 years old on July 20, 2010. Lehigh Presbytery has 20 delegate spaces. Delegations must include one adult for every nine young people. Adults must be at least 21 years old on July 20, 2010.
- THEME:** The theme for 2010 is "For Such a Time as This". The theme is developed throughout the week through worship, games, small groups, daily presentations and activities.
- WHERE:** The Triennium will be held on the campus of Purdue University, West Lafayette, Indiana. West Lafayette is located 65 miles northwest of the city of Indianapolis along Interstate 65. It is approximately 135 miles southeast of Chicago
- WHEN:** The Triennium runs July 20 (Tuesday) through July 24 (Sunday). Registration begins at noon and ends at 6:00 pm on Tuesday the 20th. The Triennium event officially begins with dinner and ends Sunday, July 24th with worship.
- INSURANCE:** The Triennium registration fee includes limited insurance coverage.
- TRAVEL:** Travel by chartered bus will be coordinated by the Lackawanna and Lehigh Presbytery. Travel departure from Pennsylvania will be on Monday, July 19, 2010 and arrival in Pennsylvania will be Monday, July 25, 2010. Times are to be determined.
- COST:** Cost per person is approximately \$850.00. The fee includes housing, meals, conference T-shirt, memento, and all registration fees, transportation and overnight lodging to and from the Triennium.
